

Bethany Family,

As we enter into Fall, you probably already noticed the focus on Discipleship Groups. We are launching six Discipleship Groups. Four existed last Spring and two are new. I would like to explain a goal for Bethany Church.

One simple goal is that every member and every regular attender of Bethany be in a Discipleship Group. Therefore, these groups have a variety of times, days, and topics. We wanted everyone regardless of age, job, gender, and relational status to have multiple opportunities to plug into a Discipleship Group. Please take the time to consider which group best fits your schedule and your needs. Then commit to the group. You may be asking "why". Why take the time out of your busy lives to come together in these Discipleship Groups?

We are called to make disciples. "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19. This command is rightfully focused upon evangelism and not just sharing the good news. We are to raise up people who are Christ followers who will, in turn, evangelize and disciple others. To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is a life-long pursuit. Before we can make disciples out of others, we must first invest time in our own discipleship. These groups are meant to grow us in our faith. As we come together and discuss Scripture and theology, and apply our understanding of these to our lives, we are growing more like Christ. We are maturing in our faith, making our efforts in evangelism and discipleship more fruitful. "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." 2 Timothy 3:16-17. When we study Scripture, we growing our faith. We gain the building blocks necessary to live life well and to complete what God has for us to do, which is good works and holy living.

These Discipleship Groups will make us better spouses, parents, grand parents, co-workers, neighbors, bosses, etc.

Another purpose behind these groups is to foster deeper relationships and fellowship. The Sunday morning worship is essential to our spiritual growth, but it is not natural to connect relationally in this setting. Discipleship Groups meet this need naturally. When we come together in groups, we can care for each other, meet the needs of each other, and sharpen our faith as we discuss life and faith. This is exactly what we see in the first church in Acts doing. "And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and the prayers." Acts 2:42. What is amazing is that, just a few verses later, Scriptures tell us that God added to their number daily. When we focus our hearts and priorities upon God, we not only grow in our faith, but we become attractive to people around us. Our faith becomes a beacon of light in this world, that when properly lit, leads people to God. The natural outcome of a robust faith is evangelism and discipleship.





This has been an incredible year of change and growth for Willow. They made the bold move to step out in faith to relocate to Hermitage, where their clients are already going to restaurants, working, and shopping. This removed a transportation barrier that they kept seeing for their clients in Transfer. It also increased the number of women they were scheduling to... at times, double what they were doing last year.

The community is incredibly caring and generous. They believe women deserve top quality medical, educational, and emotional care. Providing medical services at cost is expensive, but ONCE a year over 350 Willow Banquet guests pledge nearly HALF of Willow's budget.

Here is a glimpse of their expanded services for the upcoming year. They are working on offering a telehealth line, designated walk-in hours, as well as, miscarriage support groups. All this is possible ONLY because of people choosing to say YES to help them move forward.


