



## WEEK 1 • VISION AND SURRENDER

### 1 Vision from God

July 7

Proverbs 29:18 – “Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint, but blessed is he who keeps the law.”

Prayer: Ask God to give Calvary Severance a clear vision and purpose for the future renovation, fundraising, and ministry.

### 2 God's Plans, Not Ours

July 8

Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord...”

Prayer: Surrender your personal plans and embrace God's greater purpose for Calvary Severance.

### 3 Seeking the Lord First

July 9

Matthew 6:33 – “But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness...”

Prayer: Ask God to center Calvary Severance's priorities and decisions on His kingdom and not earthly concerns. Pray the same for yourself.

### 4 Listening for God's Voice

July 10

John 10:27 – “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.”

Prayer: Spend time quietly listening to the Holy Spirit's guidance regarding your personal involvement.

### 5 Trusting God's Timing

July 11

Ecclesiastes 3:1 – “For everything there is a season...”

Prayer: We've had some challenges to this point working with Weld County on the building's new use. Ask God to help Calvary Severance trust His perfect timing in completing this effort.

### 6 Unity in Vision

July 12

Philippians 2:2 – “...being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind.”

Prayer: Pray for church-wide unity and shared passion for what God is calling the church to build.

### 7 Dedication to God's Glory

July 13

1 Corinthians 10:31 – “So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.”

Prayer: Commit the project to God's glory, not personal or organizational pride.



## WEEK 2 • FAITH AND COURAGE

### 8 Stepping Out in Faith

July 14 Hebrews 11:1 – “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.”  
Prayer: Ask for courage to trust God, even when the path ahead is uncertain.

### 9 God's Provision

July 15 Philippians 4:19 – “And my God will supply every need of yours...”  
Prayer: Believe and ask for God's provision for Calvary Severance—financial and spiritual—for the campaign.

### 10 Faith Over Fear

July 16 Isaiah 41:10 – “Fear not, for I am with you...”  
Prayer: Reject fear and choose faith in God's promises for our Body.

### 11 Remembering God's Faithfulness

July 17 Lamentations 3:22–23 – “The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases...”  
Prayer: Reflect on past seasons of God's provision and faithfulness both in your own life, and the life of Calvary Severance.

### 12 Bold Prayers

July 18 Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly...”  
Prayer: Pray big, bold prayers for God's abundant provision and power.

### 13 Walking by Faith

July 19 2 Corinthians 5:7 – “For we walk by faith, not by sight.”  
Prayer: Pray for perseverance when you can't yet see the results.

### 14 Confidence in Christ

July 20 Philippians 1:6 – “...he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion...”  
Prayer: Trust God to finish what He has started through Calvary Severance.



## WEEK 3 • GENEROSITY AND SACRIFICE

### 15 God Loves a Cheerful Giver

July 21

2 Corinthians 9:7 – “Each one must give as he has decided in his heart...”

Prayer: Ask God to create a joyful, willing heart in you and others.

### 16 Giving as Worship

July 22

Romans 12:1 – “...present your bodies as a living sacrifice...”

Prayer: Offer your resources, time, and talents as acts of worship.

### 17 The Widow's Example

July 23

Mark 12:43–44 – “...she out of her poverty has put in everything she had...”

Prayer: Reflect on sacrificial giving and ask God how He wants you to give.

### 18 Holding Nothing Back

July 24

Acts 4:32–35 – “...no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own...”

Prayer: Pray for open-handed generosity among Calvary Severance members.

### 19 Stewarding God's Gifts

July 25

1 Peter 4:10 – “As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another...”

Prayer: Ask God to show you how to steward your gifts—financial and spiritual—for this season.

### 20 Investing in Eternal Things

July 26

Matthew 6:19–21 – “...lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven...”

Prayer: Ask God to shift your focus to eternal investment over temporary comfort.

### 21 The Heart Behind the Gift

July 27

1 Chronicles 29:9 – “Then the people rejoiced because they had given willingly...”

Prayer: Pray for willing, joyful hearts in giving to The Building.



## WEEK 4 • SERVING AND BUILDING TOGETHER

### 22 Each Doing Their Part

July 28 Ephesians 4:16 – "...when each part is working properly, makes the body grow..."  
Prayer: Ask God how He wants you to contribute through serving Calvary Severance.

### 23 A Heart to Serve

July 29 Mark 10:45 – "...the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve..."  
Prayer: Pray for servant-hearted leadership and participation.

### 24 Working Together in Unity

July 30 Nehemiah 4:6 – "...for the people had a mind to work."  
Prayer: Pray for a shared work ethic and unity in building.

### 25 Encouraging One Another

July 31 Hebrews 10:24–25 – "...stir up one another to love and good works..."  
Prayer: Ask God to help you encourage others in this season.

### 26 Bearing One Another's Burdens

Aug 1 Galatians 6:2 – "Bear one another's burdens..."  
Prayer: Intercede for those who are struggling emotionally or financially within Calvary Severance and our community.

### 27 Using Your Talents for God

Aug 2 Colossians 3:23–24 – "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord..."  
Prayer: Ask God to reveal where your gifts are needed in this season.

### 28 God Builds the House

Aug 3 Psalm 127:1 – "Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain."  
Prayer: Ask God to be the foundation and builder of this vision at Calvary Severance.



## WEEK 5 • GRATITUDE AND EXPECTATION

### 29 Give Thanks in All Things

Aug 4

1 Thessalonians 5:18 – "...give thanks in all circumstances..."

Prayer: Thank God for what He is doing, and will do, even before results are visible.

### 30 Celebrating God's Goodness

Aug 5

Psalms 100:5 – "For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever..."

Prayer: Praise God for His goodness and past provision in our church.

### 31 Remembering God's Promises

Aug 6

Deuteronomy 7:9 – "...he is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant..."

Prayer: Thank God for His unchanging promises.

### 32 Rejoicing Together

Aug 7

Philippians 4:4 – "Rejoice in the Lord always..."

Prayer: Pray for joy and celebration throughout the Calvary Severance church body.

### 33 Gratitude in the Waiting

Aug 8

Psalms 27:14 – "Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage..."

Prayer: Thank God for what He's doing even when answers seem delayed.

### 34 Peace in the Process

Aug 9

John 14:27 – "Peace I leave with you..."

Prayer: Pray for peace over finances, planning, and leadership decisions within our church.

### 35 The Joy of the Lord

Aug 10

Nehemiah 8:10 – "...the joy of the Lord is your strength."

Prayer: Ask for deep, sustaining joy during this time of growth.



## WEEK 6 • CELEBRATION AND DEDICATION

### 36 A Sacrifice of Praise

Aug 11

Hebrews 13:15 – “Let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God...”

Prayer: Offer your praise and thanksgiving as a daily habit of worship.

### 37 Dedication of the Work

Aug 12

Exodus 40:33–34 – “...Moses finished the work. Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting...”

Prayer: Dedicate our financial efforts and every effort to God's glory and presence.

### 38 Honoring God with Our Success

Aug 13

Deuteronomy 8:18 – “You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth...”

Prayer: Give thanks and humility as success and pledges come in.

### 39 Sharing the Story

Aug 14

Psalms 105:1 – “Oh give thanks to the Lord; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples!”

Prayer: Pray for boldness in testifying about God's provision and stirring faith in others.

### 40 All for His Glory

Aug 15

Romans 11:36 – “For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.”

Prayer: Declare the whole journey for God's glory. Give Him all honor and praise.
