### A Note from Jarryn

Last weekend the district held the Sr. High Rally in Des Moines. This year the theme was "God's Calling Your Life". Our theme verse was Ephesians 2:10

"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

Over the Mass Events, and Sectionals the youth learned what Vocation means. Many of the youth had never thought of the difference between a job and a vocation. This rally talked about the difference and how we are God's masterpiece and he has called us to our vocations.

If you have never thought of the difference between a job and vocation, a job is that thing people go to from 9 to 5 (or whatever hours you work) because they need to make a livelihood. It is your career. It's that focus on day to day task and your professional profile that earns you a living.

A vocation is a calling that is much deeper and comes from God. It is the meaning in one's life and actions that are seen through faith. It includes all areas of our lives such as being a spouse, parent, sibling, friend, church leader, or citizen. It is what we are; where we use the gifts God has given us to serve others. Rather that those good works we do in our vocations help our neighbors and build them up. No matter what your vocations are they are all just as important cause they come from God. Vocation is the way God created us to bring love and serve others in our world. It's about looking outside of ourselves and not being focused on ourselves. When we focus on ourselves and how the world thinks we should be, we will see faults and mistakes. That we aren't as perfect as the models or have as much stuff as those Tik Tok influencers. That our careers according to the world might not be as glamours or make us as wealthy as another. Leading us to believe that we are failures. If we follow the world in putting careers in front of vocations we will miss the joy God has given us in serving others in those areas.



#### Our Savior Lutheran Church Council Meeting Minutes, November 3, 2025

The meeting was called to order by President Rod Bradley at 7pm.

Opening devotion/prayer by Alan Suntken.

Review of minutes from October 14, 2025, Council meeting- approved as read.

#### **Pastor Report**

#### Worship Attendance

Worship attendance is up overall at Our Savior. We saw a slight drop to our Saturday evening services (3 people on average), but an increase on Sunday mornings (almost 16 people on average). It is nice to see some new faces in the congregation. I will need to work to get to know them and get them assimilated into the life of the congregation. Bethlehem saw a slight drop in Sunday attendance; however, we have seen many new faces during the weeks. I believe that harvest had something to do with low numbers this year. Seems like more of the farmers were out in the field compared to last year.

#### **Projectors**

We have an official quote from Sweetwater based upon our Sanctuary environment. Their recommendation is to go with the Vivitek DU5053Z. This is a 7,500 lumens projector with a laser phosphor system. These come with a \$4,700 price tag. I do not believe that we need the mounting hardware (\$1,450 for 4) as what we have is very similar to what they would like to sell us. Total price on 4 projectors would be \$18,796 plus tax. Option B would be to go with the Sony VPL-PHZ61 projector like we bought for the back of the church. It has lower lumens (6,400) so might not be as bright as the ones recommended. Also, it has a laser diode lamp, which apparently needs more maintenance and shorter life span (but brighter colors?). The cost per projector is \$3,600 each (\$14,396 for 4 plus tax).

Motion by Steve Frazier- seconded by Alan Suntken to present Vivitek projectors to the voters. Motion carries.

#### **Advent Service**

We will once again host our Advent Services for the community. We will be doing "A Nativity Story" from the Skit Guys. This includes 5 videos (3 for Advent and 1 for Christmas Eve and 1 for Christmas Day) and a printable devotional booklet. Our services will be on Wednesday Evenings at 7:00p.m. for Our Savior and 5:30p.m. for Bethlehem. Pastors will take turns preaching. Pastor Wade is also offering a late morning service for the community at Zion. We decided to divide and conquer to get as many people involved as possible. On Wednesday evenings we will have a meal prior to each service. This is all tentative at this time, but it is my plan for Advent.

#### **Confirmation Retreat**

All of our confirmation kiddos have agreed to attend the Confirmation Retreat in November. We will be heading out around 6pm on Friday November 14. We have one student who made honor band and will be coming up a little later in the evening after the concert. Pastor Wade and I will be doing most of the teaching. Pastor Ted was unsure if he would make it or not because of a Capital Campaign they have going on. Jarryn will also be attending and helping with games and activities. Chuck Downing will also help chaperon. At this time, we are looking to borrow Unity Ridges van for the trip. Pastor Wade will remain the whole weekend. I secured Pastor Jon to lead his worship service. I will come back Friday night or Saturday morning when I am done teaching so I can lead our three services. We will be covering the Sacraments (Baptism, Communion, Confession/Absolution).
