Heart: What are a few feelings that were especially present in the past year?

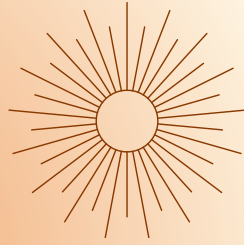
Relationships: What kinds of relationships do I desire & need? What do I need to do to make room for those relationships?
