Jonah 1:1-3

## "God's Offensive Mercy"

2. Flip to Jonah 4.2. Why does Jonah say he ran away in the first place? What does this tell us about Jonah's attitude toward the Ninevites? Toward God?
3. How can we hold a mirror up and see ourselves in Jonah? Who would God showing mercy to offend you? How does this point us to Jesus?
