## "From Cursed to Blessed"

### Galatians 3:10-14

1. Reliance on \_\_\_\_\_ performance always results in a \_\_\_\_\_  
(vs 10-12)

A) Because it requires \_\_\_\_\_ obedience, and no  
one \_\_\_\_\_ (vs 10-11)

B) Because it rejects the \_\_\_\_\_ one (Vs 12)

promise that actually always leads to the curse of death

## QUESTIONS FOR THE CAR RIDE OR COMMUNITY GROUP:

1. Where have you found yourself trying to rely on your own performance to gain or maintain right standing with God? How does Paul argue that as a failed path to blessing in vs 10-12?
2. Connecting the dots: how does what Christ did for us (vs 13) gift us Abraham's blessing (vs 14)? See vs 8 for help.
3. In vs 14, Paul says Christ's redemption enables us to receive the promised Spirit through faith. Read Romans 8.5-17. What does the gift of the Spirit offer us, and which of those truths do you most need to hear today?
