Throughout Lent, we have been living with our brokenness—both here and now in our families and the world—and through time from the earliest days after leaving the Garden. As we look towards Holy Week, we begin by singing with joy and lifting our praises in the deep conviction that God's love endures forever. We know that God has sent Jesus to us, bringing a kin-dom we could not possibly imagine. Passion Sunday—which rehearses the entire story from hosannas to the crucifixion to Easter—offers us an overview, a summary, of what we will be walking through. On the first day of Holy Week, we are reminded that while love brings joy, it also brings deep grief. As this week goes forward, we will find ourselves moving through the valley of the shadow of death—both here and now in whatever ways we are inhabiting it—and through the deep story of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. 


# Easter and Pentecost to be celebrated in common by Eastern and Western Christianity

In 2025, all Christians will celebrate Easter and Pentecost on the same dates (April 20 and June 8 respectively) as the Easter calendars of Eastern and Western Christianity coincide. This will be a reminder that attempts to establish a common date for Easter began with the Council of Nicaea in the year 325. The Eastern Orthodox patriarch of Constantinople, Bartholomew, has expressed a desire that Christians in the East and the West begin celebrating Easter on a "unified date" rather than adhere to separate Lenten calendars. Pope Francis has also expressed his intent to reach an agreement to establish a common date for Easter: "I renew my appeal that this coincidence may serve as an appeal to all Christians to take a decisive step forward toward unity around a common date for Easter."





#### Refugee Family Co-Sponsorship with Lutheran Family Services:

Our Co-Sponsorship Team is reaching out to see if anyone in the congregation is interested in joining them as they are in the process of working with a Refugee Family. A refugee is someone who has been forced to flee his or her country because of persecution, war or violence. In order for a refugee to enter the US, they have gone through a vetting process and are legally recognized as needing international protection due to persecution or a well-founded fear of it.

73 percent of all refugees and other people in need of international protection come from just five countries: <u>Afghanistan</u>, <u>Syria</u>, <u>Venezuela</u>, <u>Ukraine</u> and <u>Sudan</u>.



A story from another congregation from several years ago. The congregation had been committed to practicing growth-giving. After the congregation reached sharing a tithe or 10% of unrestricted offerings to the mission of Christ through the Grand Canyon Synod and ELCA Churchwide, the leadership continued to increase by 1% what was being shared outside the walls of the congregation. In an unexpected move at a congregational meeting, a voting member requested that the benevolence or that portion of the mission spending plan (budget) shared outside the walls of the congregation be reduced to give two staff members an additional raise (they were already being fairly compensated). The motion was amended to include, if by November of the current year offerings demonstrated the 2% benevolence reduction could be restored, the leadership would reinstate. Come November there was more than enough to restore the 2% reduction and the following year the congregation continued to increase by another 1% giving beyond their own walls. As a congregation and as individuals we are invited to remember daily God's Impossible Promise of Enough.

#### Pastor Nanette's sermon title: "From Hosannas to Crucify Him!"

#### Isaiah 50:4-9

<sup>4</sup>The Lord God has given me the tongue of a teacher, that I may know how to sustain the weary with a word. Morning by morning he wakens— wakens my ear to listen as those who are taught. <sup>5</sup>The Lord God has opened my ear, and I was not rebellious, I did not turn backward. <sup>6</sup>I gave my back to those who struck me, and my cheeks to those who pulled out the beard; I did not hide my face from insult and spitting. <sup>7</sup>The Lord God helps me; therefore I have not been disgraced; therefore I have set my face like flint, and I know that I shall not be put to shame; 8he who vindicates me is near. Who will contend with me? Let us stand up together. Who are my adversaries? Let them confront me. 9It is the Lord God who helps me; who will declare me guilty? All of them will wear out like a garment; the moth will eat them up.

## Philippians 2:5-11

<sup>5</sup>Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup>who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, <sup>7</sup>but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, 8he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death— even death on a cross. 9Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup>so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

#### Luke 19:28-44

<sup>28</sup>After he had said this, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. <sup>29</sup>When he had

come near Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of the disciples, <sup>30</sup>saying, "Go into the village ahead of you, and as you enter it you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. <sup>31</sup>If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' just say this, 'The Lord needs it.'" 32So those who were sent departed and found it as he had told them. <sup>33</sup>As they were untying the colt, its owners asked them, "Why are you untying the colt?" <sup>34</sup>They said, "The Lord needs it." <sup>35</sup>Then they brought it to Jesus; and after throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. <sup>36</sup>As he rode along, people kept spreading their cloaks on the road. <sup>37</sup>As he was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power that they had seen, <sup>38</sup>saying, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in the highest heaven!" <sup>39</sup>Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, order your disciples to stop." 40 He answered, "I tell you, if these were silent, the stones would shout out." <sup>41</sup>As he came near and saw the city, he wept over it, <sup>42</sup>saying, "If you, even you, had only recognized on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. <sup>43</sup>Indeed, the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up ramparts around you and surround you, and hem you in on every side. 44They will crush you to the ground, you and your children within you, and they will not leave within you one stone upon another; because you did not recognize the time of your visitation from God."
