## **God the Holy Spirit**

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity. Equal with God the Father, and God the Son sharing in their divinity. He has powerful presence and ministry in the life of a believer, and the advance of the gospel of Christ.

Intellect: The Holy Spirit knows and understands and has a(Romans 8:27); the Holy Spiri searches all things, and knows(1 Corinthians 2:10-11)
Emotion: The Holy Spirit experiences emotion so He can feel and ( Ephesians 4:30).
<b>Will</b> : The Holy Spirit determines and acts decisively by giving (1 Corinthians 12:7-11). The Holy Spirit sets apart for(Acts 13:2)

Bares witness to Christ (John 15:26) (John 16:13) (John 16:14)
Active in salvation
Read John 16:7-8. What does this teach that the Holy Spirit does?
<b>Read</b> John 3:5-8. what does Jesus say must happen to a person in order to see the kingdom of God?
<b>Regeneration</b> describes the work of the Holy Spirit to impart spiritual life, leading to saving faith and salvation (Titus 3:5)
Baptism in the Spirit occurs once at the time of salvation. It describes the work of the Holy Spirit

**Sealing of the Holy Spirit** is the marking and Indwelling presence of the Spirit in the life of a believer. It is God's pledge and promise that believers are sons of God, and will receive the future inheritance. (Ephesians 1:13-14) (Romans 8:15)

<b>Being filled with the spirit</b> is to be under His domination and control. It is to confess sin, and surrender the will to the Spirit. (Ephesians 5:18)
<b>Producing the fruit of the spirit</b> is to grow in the character traits that are a part of greater sanctification and holiness. (Galatians 5:22-23)
Read Galatians 5:22-23. What is the "fruit of the spirit"? Why is it singular?

Active in Christian ministry
The Holy Spirit gives spiritual gifts to every believer for the purpose of ministry and building the body of Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:7)
