God's word describes the life of a disciple of Jesus as one that is new and transformed. Once we are united in Jesus by faith in His death, burial and resurrection, we become one with Him. We take on His identity and His life. That means that the person we were before trusting Jesus is gone, and a new person now lives. The new person we become, now lives by the power of the Holy Spirit, and is being conformed into the image of Jesus daily. There are times during the journey of our new life of discipleship when we wrestle with tendencies from our old nature. But we have confidence and we fight those battles FROM our new nature and identity in Jesus. Because Jesus has made us new, we no longer have to be captive to sin and an old way of thinking therefore we can be free to live in righteousness.
