#### 2025 Annual Conference Report

The theme of Conference, "A Movement of the Heart", focused on how God transforms us and how God molds and shapes us and allows us to be agents of change in and around our community.

The Journey in Understanding task force, mentioned last year, was created to lead conversations on reconciliation related to past LGBTQ issues. Their report focused on active listening rather than rhetoric and votes that tend to divide us. Their presentation can be seen in the June 12 Afternoon Session video.

There were also votes on several constitutional amendments from the 2024 General Conference related to regionalization, gender and ability, racial justice and educational requirements for clergy (see pages 39 to 70 in the Book of Reports). However, we won't know the results until later this year when all Conferences around the world have completed their votes and the delegate votes have been aggregated.

A couple of exciting missional items to report:

- UMCOR kits were organized at the district level for the third year in a row. So far, the total is 14,311 total kits for a total value of \$245,985.
- As of the end of Conference, \$42,000 has been collected for the conference offering to support 2 initiatives: Disaster Response including assistance in the Western North Carolina Conference in the wake of Hurricane Helene and the Cal-Pac Conference after the LA wildfires. Part of the offering also goes to Partnerships of Hope where we support those in Brazil, Mozambique, Cambodia, Haiti, Vietnam, and Native American Ministries.

Great News! Pastor Fran will be back with us for another year.
