OVERVIEW

KEY IDEAS

GENERAL REVELATION

God reveals Himself to everyone through what He has created.

AWE

A word that describes how “wow” God is. When we say He is “awesome,” we are saying that He fills us with wonder.

JOHN 14:9

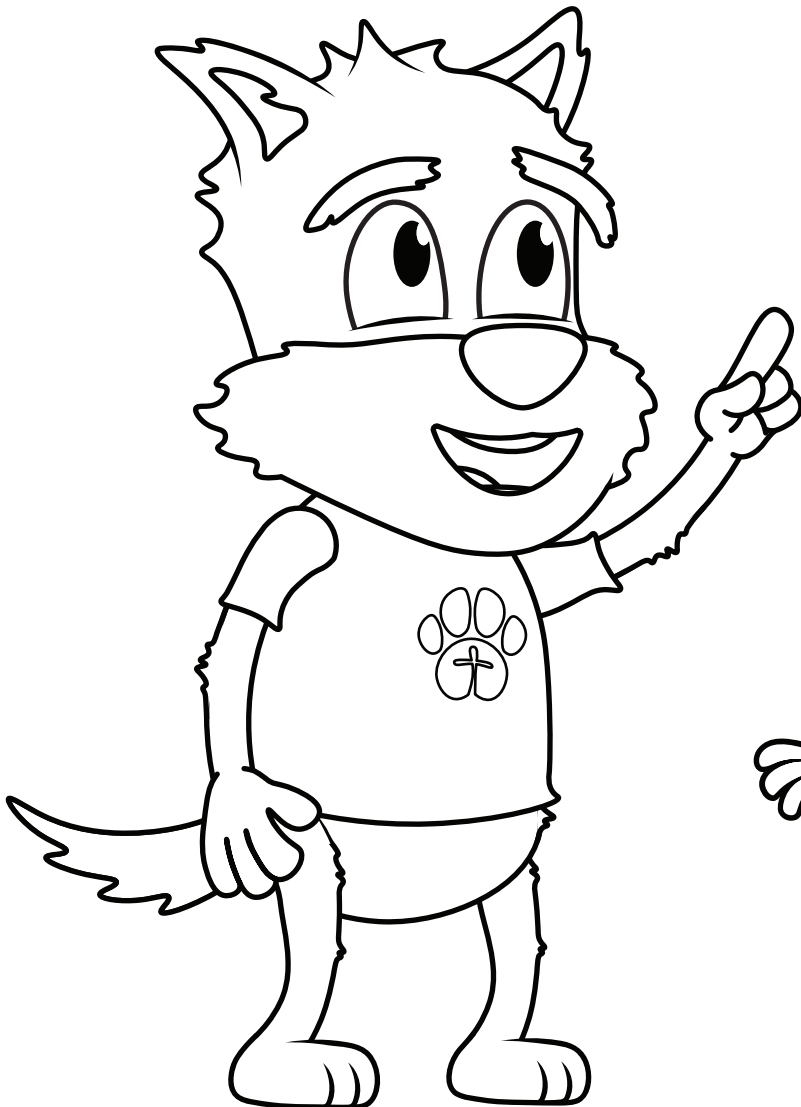
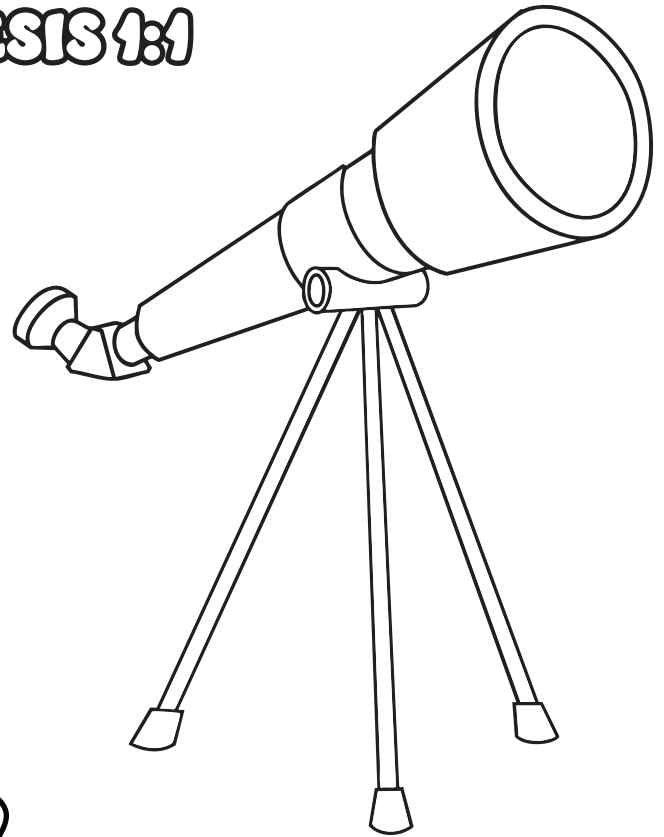

GOD RESTED

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OVERVIEW

God rested on the Seventh Day, and we can take one day in seven to rest in what Jesus has done through the Cross.

KEY IDEAS

RESTING FOR GOD DOESN'T MEAN SLEEP

The Bible tells us that God neither slumbers nor sleeps. Resting means that He knew that creation was “just right,” and that all that needed to be done had been done.

IT IS FINISHED

Jesus said from the Cross: “it is finished.” He came to undo the work of the devil, and that “finishing” is moving slowly but surely through all things. We will see its final result when Jesus returns and all that is evil and bad disappears.

BIBLE VERSES

GENESIS 2:2-3

² And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. ³ So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.

PSALM 121:3-4

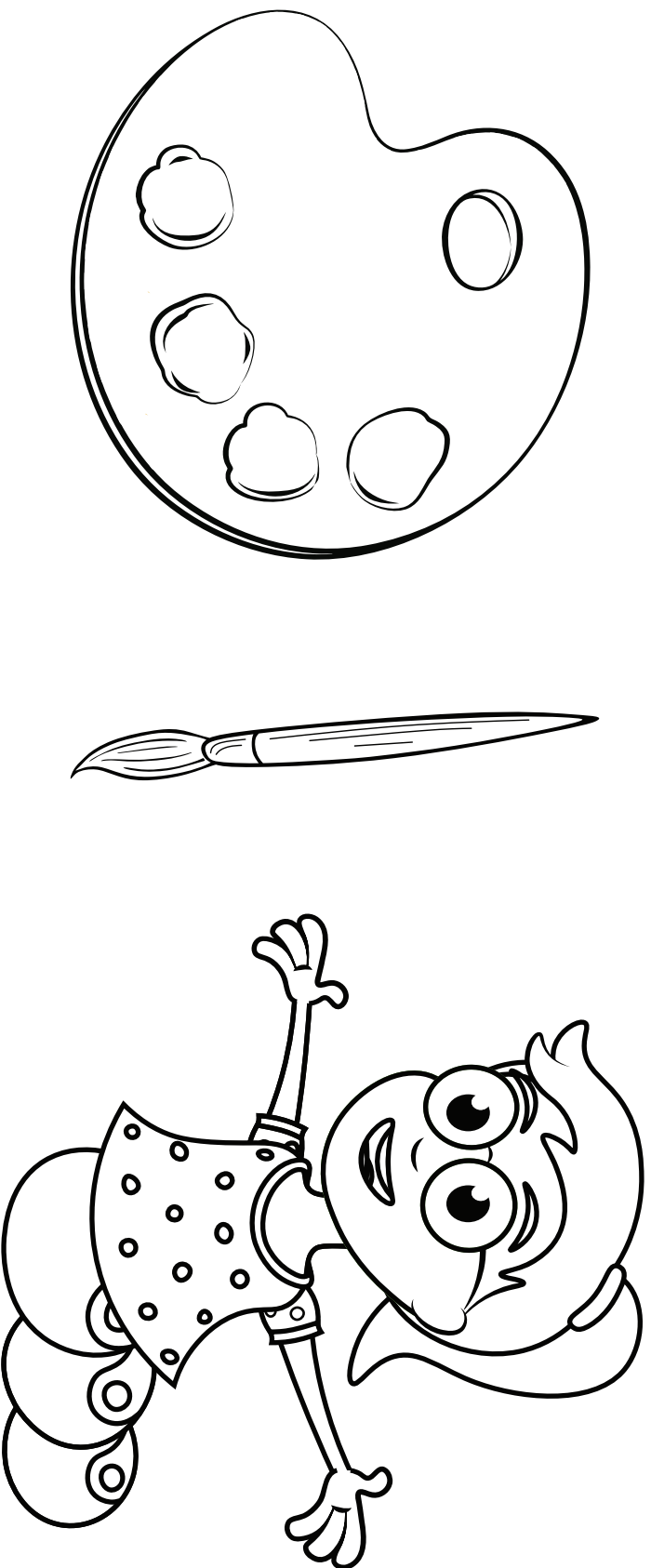
³ He will not let your foot be moved; he who keeps you will not slumber. ⁴ Behold, he who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

OVERVIEW

Through the Cross, Jesus has defeated Satan. When we trust in Jesus, we no longer have to fear the Serpent of death's sting.

KEY IDEAS

ENMITY

"Greatly dislike." God told the Serpent that tempted Adam and Eve to sin that he would be greatly disliked.

THE DEVIL

The Serpent was the disguise of the Enemy of Old, Satan. He tempted and tricked Adam and Eve into disobeying.

JESUS IS THE ONE

God promised to send someone to "crush the Serpent's head." This promise was fulfilled through Jesus.

GENESIS 3:15

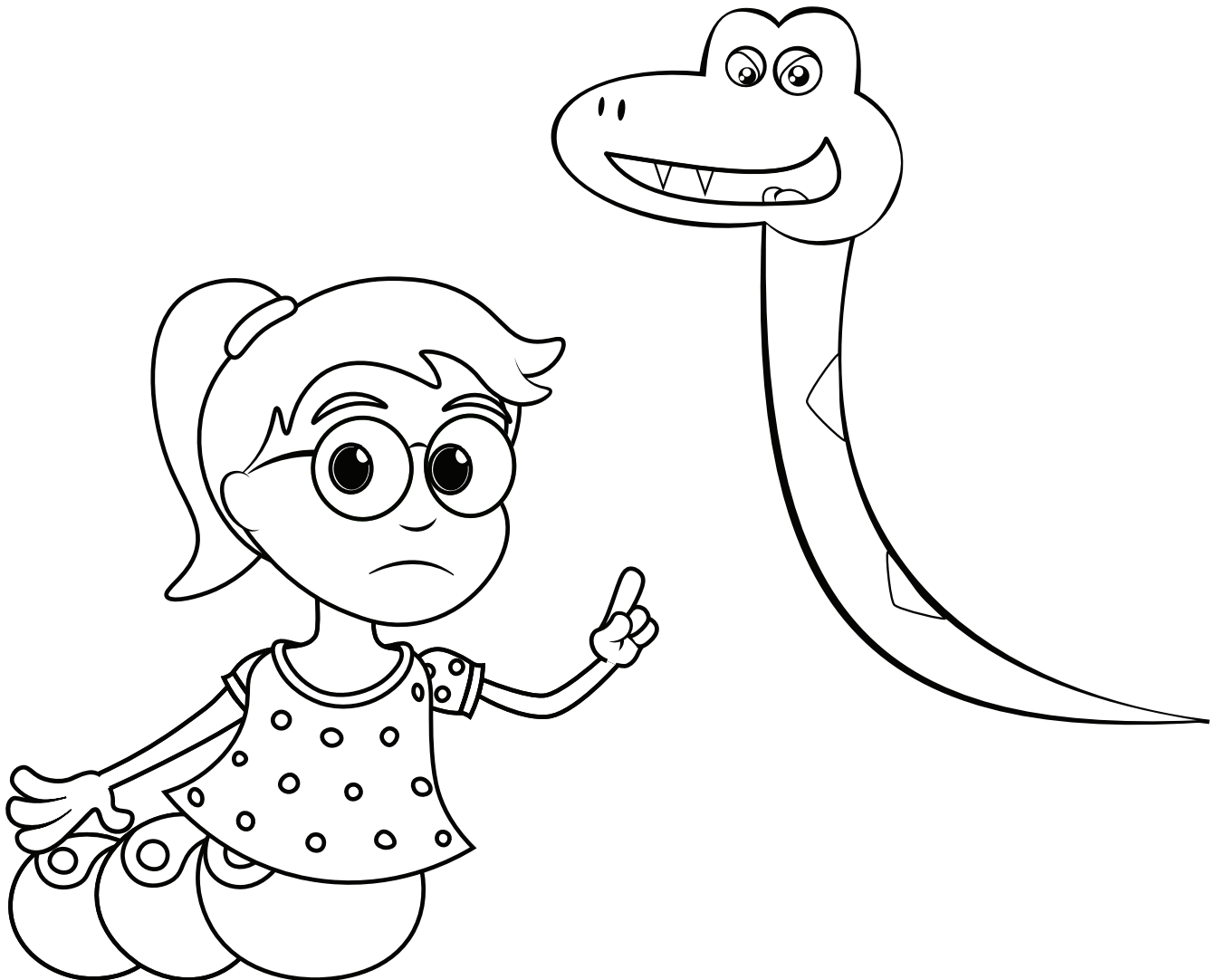
I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring, he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.

OVERVIEW

KEY IDEAS

GOD'S GIFT

God gave us Jesus, His one and only Son. This shows us the depths of God's heart and His love for us.

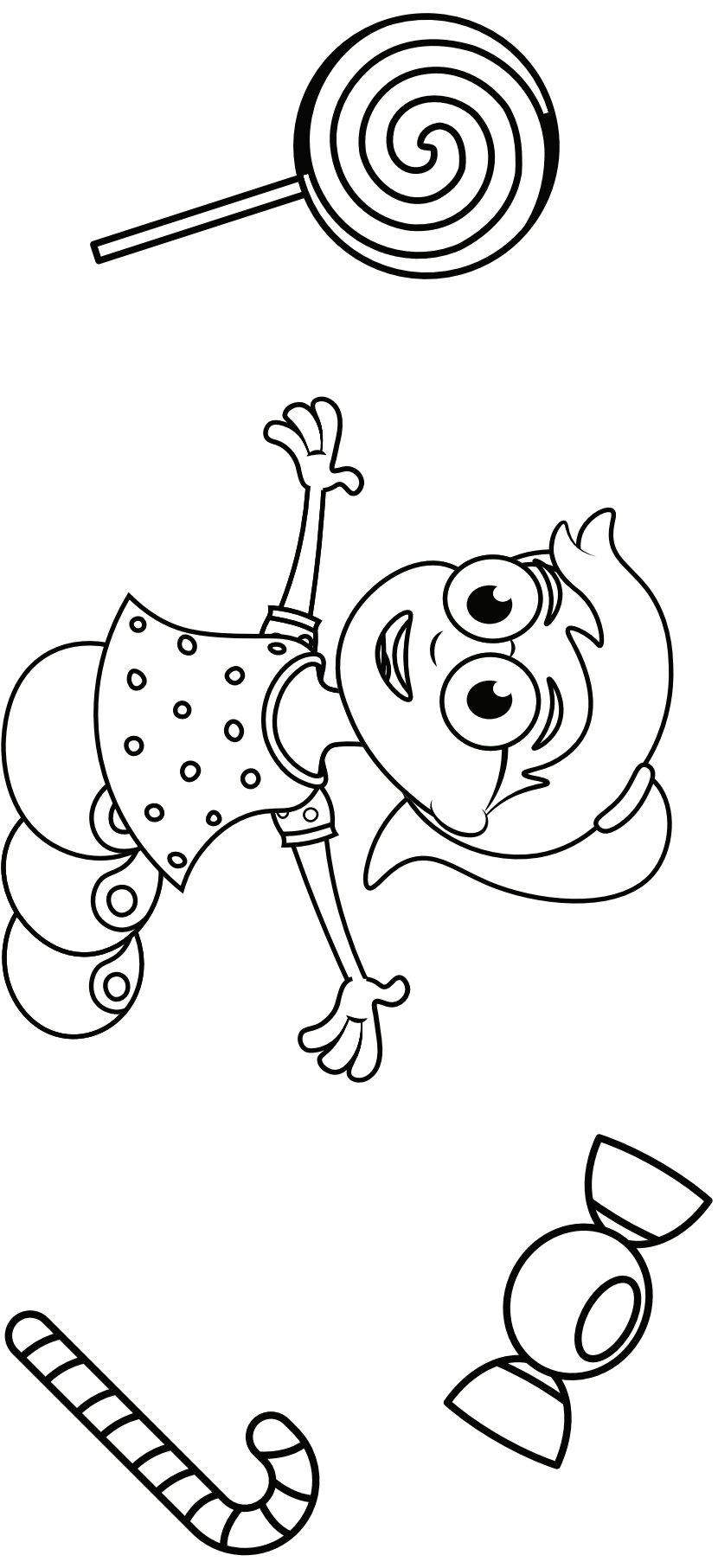
BIBLE VERSES

OVERVIEW

KEY IDEAS

THE BIG PICTURE

PUZZLE PIECES

God showed us what Jesus would be like through the lives of people in the Old Testament.

PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER

People needed Jesus to “put the pieces together” and show them how the Old Testament pointed to Him.

GENESIS 5:28-29

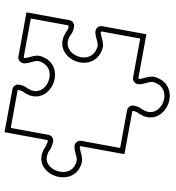
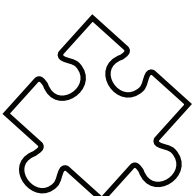
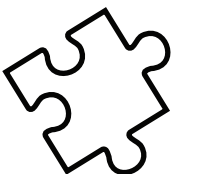
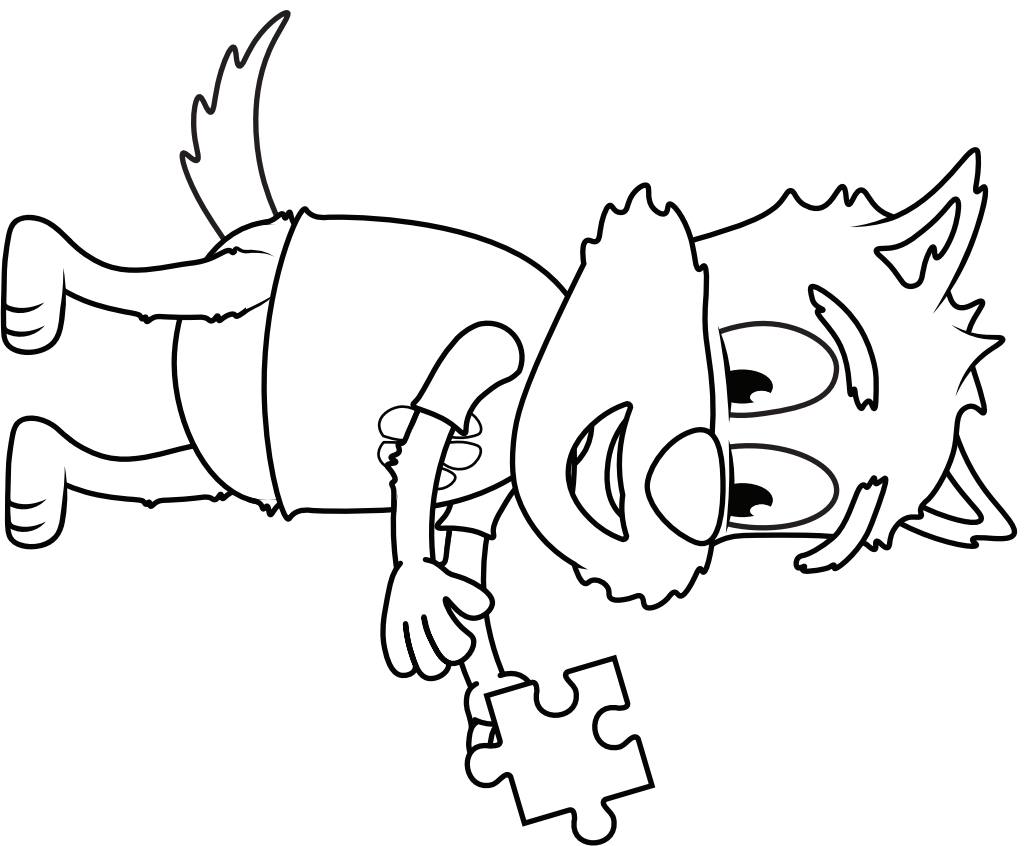
