OVERVIEW

WHAT DID WE LEARN?

- Correction—when it's given in love—isn't meant to tear us down but to help us grow.
- Proverbs 25:12 tells us that wise correction is as valuable as gold to the one who will truly listen, and in Jesus, we see the perfect example of this.
- Jesus doesn't correct us to condemn us—He corrects us to save us, to shape us into people who reflect His love and truth.
- Because of His grace, even when the correction stings, we can trust that He is working for our good.
- •When we remember that, correction becomes a treasure—something to thank God for, not to runaway from.
