OUERVIEW

WHAT DID WE LEARN?

- Even when everything seems to go wrong, true joy is still possible.
- Christian joy isn't about perfect days or getting exactly what we want. It comes from knowing God loves us, from the laughter and friendship we share, and from seeing His goodness even in messy, unexpected moments.
- Joy is a gift from God. It comes from His Spirit and it comes from knowing that Jesus will always be
 enough, no matter what, and when we share it with others, it spreads His love in a way nothing else
 can.
