OVERVIEW

WHAT DID WE LEARN?

- Jesus came at Christmas to bring that peace. He mends what is broken between us and God by forgiving our sin and welcoming us into His family.
- Once our hearts rest in His peace, we can show that same peace and kindness to others, even when it's hard.
