Introduction:

A prayer for 2026: “Lord, would you please use me to lead at least one person to Christ this year, and give me the pleasure of helping to disciple them?”

Today we begin a new focus/emphasis on the second half of our Mission Statement: “Enjoying and Sharing the Abundant Life of Jesus.”

DEFINITION: The “Each One Win One” campaign is a year-long outreach effort where every believer in our church commits to praying for the lost, sharing the gospel, and asking God to use them to lead at least one person to Christ by the end of 2026.

7 Foundational Principles

- 1. The Principle of the Great Commission:** It’s not just for the Apostles; it’s for every believer. (Matthew 28:18-20)

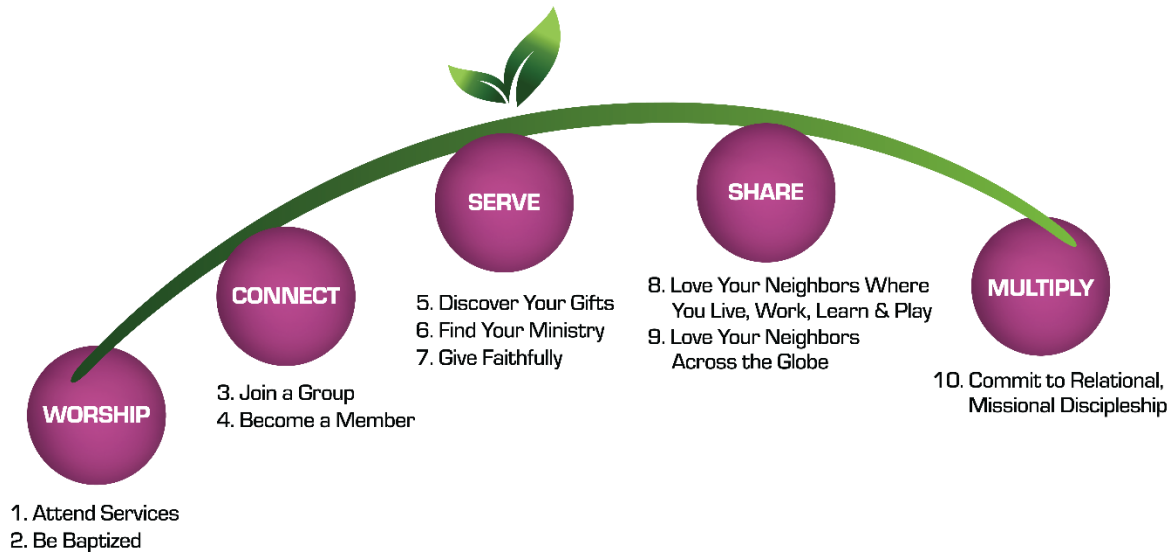
- 2. The Principle of Fishing:** If you don’t go fishing, you’ll never catch anything. (Matthew 4:19)

- 4. The Principle of Sowing:** It takes time to reap a harvest. (Galatians 6:9)

5. The Principle of Teamwork: You're not alone.

6. The Principle of Prayer: Prayer is God's way of inviting us to participate in the miracle of salvation while reminding us that he is sovereign. (James 4:2; Matthew 7:7)
