7 Marks of Maturity

- 1. **PASSIONATE WORSHIP** pursuing ever-deepening intimacy with God, abiding in his love, enjoying a vibrant life of prayer and corporate worship in a local church.
- 2. **RESILIENT FAITH** walking in the power and wisdom of the Spirit, desiring to bear fruit in every area of life, knowing that following Jesus will require obedience, perseverance and trust.
- 3. **BIBLICAL HUNGER** feeding on the word of God daily, renewing our minds with truth, rooted and grounded in the doctrines of the Christian faith.
- 4. **HEART HOLINESS** seeking a life of integrity and accountability with the support of genuine friends, growing in the grace and knowledge of the Lord, experiencing persistent freedom from sin's power and persuasion.
- 5. **INTENTIONAL DISCIPLE-MAKING** building relationships with non-Christians, sharing the gospel in word and deed, leading the lost to faith in Christ, helping them become mature, reproducing followers of Jesus.
- 6. **GRACIOUS LOVE** Embracing others with the love of Jesus inside and outside the church, modeling healthy life-giving relationships with our family, friends and neighbors, living out the one another commands of Scripture.
- 7. **JOYFUL SERVICE** Demonstrating Christ's heart of humility and compassion, discovering ways to exercise our spiritual gifts in the church and community, eagerly giving our time, talents and treasure for the sake of God's kingdom.

Disciple-Making Process



Our Disciple-Making Process is portrayed as fruit on a vine because apart from Christ we can do nothing (John 15:5). Bearing fruit is the result of enjoying and sharing the abundant life of Jesus. The process includes **5 Growth Areas** and **10 Action Steps** that every believer at Campus can pursue to become a mature, fully-equipped follower of Jesus.
