I spend a lot of time in the car with my grandchildren. This gives me their undivided attention to bring up subjects to talk about and naturally turn the conversations to the things of the Lord. We have talked about various subjects: God's creation and how powerful He is; how God cares about what they are feeling; how to lean on God when they are having troubles with friends at school; what happens when a Believer dies; explanations of verses they are learning in Awana and how to apply them to their lives. I find it is the conversations that happen spontaneously that turn into the most important teaching times for children. As a grandparent, I need to always try to be ready to look for these opportunities as I "walk along the road" with my grandchildren.
