



# Areas of Service - Youth Ministry

## Weekly Opportunities

### Sunday School Teacher

This person will be someone who has a desire to see teenagers grow, able to build a relationship with these teens, willing to study and grow as a follower of Christ, and able to teach what they learn to our teens. Our Sunday school is broken up into 4 classes: Junior High Boys, Junior High Girls, 9th and 10th Grades, and 11th and 12th Grades. Each class has a two year curriculum cycle they teach from.

### Substitute Sunday School Teacher

This would be someone who wouldn't mind stepping in from time to time to serve as a substitute when we have teachers out. This happens periodically because our teachers are people and sometime they are gone or get sick, and we need someone to step in and help teach. This could be you!

### Wednesday Night Small Group Leader

Our midweek Bible study is fantastic! We have a game, worship that is led by our student praise band, and a large group Bible study with small group discussion. Usually what happens is I teach the large group lesson, and several times throughout the lesson I will pause and give the small groups a chance to discuss a question or a topic we had just talked about. You as a small group leader would just help facilitate that discussion, keeping the teens on track and asking follow up questions to drive the conversation. Biggest need as of right now (2/24) is a female small group leader.

## Throughout the Year

### Host Homes for DiscipleNow

Usually once a year we have a DiscipleNow weekend, a weekend where our students have worship and large group studies together, and they stay the night at host homes from our church and have small group studies there. You would provide your home to a small group of teens and another adult leader for the weekend. You do not have to do anything other than provide a home.

### Youth Camp Sponsor

Love teens but not sleep?! This week is for you! Come with us to youth camp and really get to know the students in an even better way that you ever could. We partner with iGoGlobal and attend Dwell Camp in Glorieta, NM. Come enjoy the crisp air, breakout sessions, concert of prayer and more and pour into these students.

### Spring Break Mission Trip Sponsor

Every year we attend a spring break mission trip. We partner with iGoGlobal again for Launchbox, an evangelism training ground of our adults and teens. We head to San Antonio and our group learns various forms of sharing the Gospel, serve at a food bank, tour a mosque and get to have a Q&A with a Muslim, learn about the Muslim faith and how to share the Gospel with them, have times of worship and group experiences as well. My favorite part of the trip is serving at the apartment complexes where most of the people are refugees from predominantly Muslim countries. We do a VBS style lesson and devotionals with the kids from the complex. This is what our kids love the most, and it is great to see the relationships we build with those kids over the years.

### Provide a Meal

Occasionally we ask for people to provide a meal, whether that be for DiscipleNow, a progressive dinner, or some other fun summer activity.

### Musician

We have an incredibly talented group of teens who lead worship each week during our Midweek bible study. We can use adults who can come alongside these teens and help their development and growth as a musician. If you can sing or play an instrument, this could be a way for you to serve.
