General Responsibilities

The Wesley Students Intern will be responsible for attending Wesley Students gatherings and events, leading and coordinating summer activities that will foster relationships, create community, and facilitate spiritual growth in children and students and the families they represent.

Specific Responsibilities

- Attend and act as a key leader on most (maybe all) trips and events.
- Lead a weekly activity/group/study with students.
- Foster an environment where students want to gather in community.
- Develop relationships with students which will entail a presence in the community outside of regularly scheduled activities.
- Assist in the development of service opportunities for students.
- Work well with Student Ministry Staff.
- Attend, engage and participate in Staff & Team Meetings (as directed)
- Learn and execute day to day tasks of student ministry such as budgeting, pre-planning and organization of events and trips.

Hours

- Sundays (Sunday mornings 9am-12pm then as needed)
- Monday-Thursday: Abbreviated business hours – usually a portion of the business day
- Retreats & Events: typically fall outside of regular weekly hours and attendance is required for interns.
- Start Date 5/11. End Date 8/9. (July 4th Week vacation)

Pay

- Pay will be discussed after the internship is awarded.
- Pay will be bi-weekly

***Applicant must be one year removed from high school.**
