

## **OUR WEEKLY BREAD**

In the first chapter of the Gospel of Luke, we read the story of Jesus' mother, Mary (Luke 1:26-56). Mary's faithfulness and joy is a powerful witness. Yet, the angel's message must have been frightening. What would it have been like to have to tell Joseph or her parents what the angel said? Whatever fear she may have felt, Mary answered the angel, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord" (Luke 1:38). She submits to God's will for her to be the chosen mother of God. Her song, called the Magnificat, begins with, "My soul magnifies the Lord" (Luke 1:46-55). It is a song of joy at being chosen and it could very well be the first Christmas song.

Many Christmas carols bring joy, which isn't the same as happiness. When things look bleak, or we encounter hard times, can we also sing a hymn of joy? The prophet Isaiah foretells a time when "the ransomed of the Lord shall return and come to Zion with singing; everlasting joy shall be upon their heads; they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away" (Isaiah 35:10). Stores are playing Christmas music, we sing at church and maybe even listen to Christmas music at home or in the car. Whether you are having a hard time finding the Christmas spirit, or if you are full of joy already, listen for the joy in the music.

Thank you, God, for the joy of the holiday season. We know why we celebrate and want to keep the focus on you. Fill our hearts with joy so that we cannot help but share our joy with others. Amen. - Rev. Tiffany McDonald, umc.org
