- Hosts teams from North America and Europe for over 20 years.

Dates: June 12–20, 2025 (Friday–Saturday)

- Flights depart from Atlanta (ATL) direct to Guatemala City.
- Plane tickets will be purchased in October.

Mandatory Team Meetings

Attendance at all pre-trip meetings is required. These gatherings prepare us culturally, spiritually, and as a team.

Expectations

Every student and leader is expected to:

- Be active at Wesley Students and Wesley Church Sunday services.
- Attend all required pre-trip meetings.
- Share about the trip with our church upon return.

Passports

- Cost: \$165 for new passports. Processing time: 4–6 weeks.
- Apply through the **U.S. State Department website**.
- Passport must be valid at the time of travel and expiration date outside of 6 months of travel
- Apply by Feb 1; passports must be in hand by April.

Vaccinations

- Required: Hepatitis A, up-to-date Tetanus.
- Optional: Malaria medication (varies by doctor).
- Some PCPs recommend Typhoid.
- No Covid vaccine or test required (as of Aug 2022).

Safety

Your student's safety is our priority.

- Hosts are highly experienced in caring for mission teams.
- We avoid unsafe areas ("zones") of Guatemala City.
- Travel after dark is limited (no later than 8:30–9:00pm).

Food & Accommodations

- Meals are prepared with safe water and care for our team.
- Hunger is never an issue; food is plentiful and safe.
- Comfortable accommodations: bunk-style rooms, attached bathrooms, pool, hammocks, game space.
- Showers may be cold—embrace the adventure!

Communication

- Aaron will have an international phone plan.
- Wi-Fi is typically available daily.
- Students' phones will be collected upon arrival for focus and safety.
- Students may use Wi-Fi to call/video home at scheduled times.

Tentative Schedule

Friday – Travel day, arrival in Guatemala City, welcome at CCCG, dinner, overnight at hostel.

Saturday – Tourist day in Antigua, overnight in Guatemala City.

Sunday – Worship at CCCG, travel to Río Dulce.

Mon–Thu – Daily village ministry: work projects (mornings) & VBS (afternoons). Evenings at retreat center with meals, devotionals, and team time.

Friday – Return to Guatemala City, send-off dinner at CCCG, overnight at hostel.

Saturday - Flight home.
