## Arrested

It's not a word that most people would want to begin a sentence with. "Hey Mom and Dad - I've been arrested and was wondering if you could come pick me up?" It is both parent and child's worst nightmare, the thing you hope never to hear. Everybody wants to steer clear of it. I have seen my fair share of resumes and I have yet to encounter the one that begins with, "I was arrested." Usually being arrested is a deal breaker, hard stop, end of the road. Where's the shredder? And why wouldn't it be? To be arrested means morality has been thrown to the wind, social norms have been violated. Doesn't it? If you've been arrested, it's the last thing, not the first thing, you begin an introduction with.

Except in the Bible. Did you know that there are over two dozen instances where people in the Bible are recorded to have been arrested. And many of them are luminaries of the faith. Joseph was imprisoned in Egypt. The prophet Jeremiah had a record a page long - read Jeremiah 32, 37 and 38. Micaiah was thrown in jail for standing up to the king. Paul made his arrests a part of his resume. He'd never make it through the second interview of any church position I had open. Peter was arraigned by no one less than King Herod, and finally, there is Jesus. We know how that turned out.

So maybe we shouldn't be surprised that in the gospel reading for Sunday, the reason for the beginning of Jesus' ministry is not because he had a "religious experience," but because he heard that John the Baptist was arrested. (Matthew 4:12-23) Or are those two things actually the same thing? That will be the subject of the sermon Sunday.

P.S. As I write these words on Wednesday, the weather forecast is unclear. Wesley's policy is always that your safety comes first and you should never endanger yourself if you are uncertain of weather conditions. **Restart:** Provided beds for 302 people in our community who otherwise would not have one. This includes 156 families, 140 adults, 164 children and 19 veterans. The ministry has given away 3,889 beds since it began in 2014.

**Men in Mission:** Built wheelchair ramps for 36 people, some of whom are Wesley members.

**Columbia County Cares:** Collected 5,913 lbs. of food and staples for the food pantry.

**Mechanics Ministry:** Received 16 vehicles from generous donors and gave away 14 to people in need.

**Yard Sales:** Two sales netted \$80,000+ for mission groups within Wesley and outside our walls.


Pick up registration packet prior to registration. Place the required items and payment in the registration packet envelope. Drop off registration packet to WPPK on the designated date.


