Behold, I Make All Things New


It's one of my favorite passages of scripture. It fills me with hope and reminds me that the ultimate gift of faith is that it always provides a future. There is no end to God.

OUR WEEKLY BREAD


...Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead. - Philippians 3:13
