Deion Sanders, head football coach of the University of Colorado, is a polarizing figure. He tends to say what he thinks without considering the consequences, which can backfire on him. Consider the case of his son Shedeur, whose drop in the NFL draft was blamed in no small part on his father's excessive lobbying. Still, and if only begrudgingly, you've got to give Deion his due. He was a two-sport professional athlete (football and baseball) - do you know how hard that is to accomplish? He then became a football coach and most recently led the bedraggled Buffalos, picked to finish last in their conference, to the playoffs. As Dizzy Dean once said, "It ain't braggin' if you've done it." The other day, however, I came across a story of the softer side of Deion.

It occurred last football season, and Sanders' team had pulled off one more upset - amazing. Afterwards in the press conference, Sanders took a question from a student reporter of the other team. However, before he answered the question he made a statement. He said to the 19-year-old, "I'm proud of you and your resilience." He was referring to the student, who was in a wheelchair because of disability. Yet even in the midst of physical adversity, the young man would not defer his dream of being a sports reporter. Deion Sanders saw him and recognized his tenacity. Following the exchange, the student posted, "I am blessed beyond belief that Deion Sanders would give me a shoutout. Thank you, Coach Prime, it means the world."

We sometimes think that the work of a Christian is to change outcomes. Humbly, we should know better. Christ has already changed the outcome - the role of church is to provide encouragement along the way.

This Sunday will be a special day. Bishop Frank Beard will be preaching for the first time in our Modern Services at 9:30 and 11.
