The Question I Get Asked

As a preacher, I get asked a lot of questions. Visitors commonly ask, "Where are the restrooms?" At Wesley, people say to me, "Is there a secret recipe for the cheese biscuits?" (Answer: There's not, but the more cheese and butter you add to the dough, the better.) Sometimes people ask me, "So do United Methodists dunk or sprinkle at baptism?" (Answer: Both, and if you want to see for yourself, come to Student Baptism Night on Sunday at 6PM in the Celebration Space.) However, the question I suppose I am consistently asked the most is, "How do I get closer to God?"

It's a good question; however, the problem is in the question itself, for it begins with "I." Why do we sometimes feel distant from God? After all, the Psalm says, "The whole earth is filled with God's glory" (Psalm 72:19). God has not moved; the problem is us. The answer to the dilemma is as it has always been. If you want more faith, you must act more faithfully. There is no substitute for this formula, and it has stood the test of time. For when we serve God, we simultaneously draw closer to God. How could we not?

And at Wesley, that is just what we're doing. Did you know this week we delivered 1,877 lbs. of food to Columbia County Cares for families in need, and almost 900 the week before? So that's more than 2,700 lbs. in less than two weeks!

And that's not all. This year in our Christmas Store outreach to Lamar Milledge Elementary School, we received gift requests for 307 different children through school teachers and social workers. This is by far the largest number we have ever received. And, as of this writing, after just one Sunday, 220 of those requests have already been chosen by us at Wesley. Wow, this is the best response we have ever had to this need!

When you are thinking of others and serving God, don't you feel in that moment a connection to what God is doing? For it is you who is making it possible.
