How You Say It

A recent article described the waning influence of a unique contribution to the southern way of life - the drawl. It, along with other southern customs such as sweet tea (three parts sugar and one part liquid), are seemingly in decline. The reasons are numerous; however, the result is inarguably the same. According to the linguistics department of the University of Georgia, the Southern drawl has experienced an exordial decline over the last fifty years.

And that's too bad. The drawl was and is distinctive. Its influence most noticeably is found in the pronunciation of the vowels. In classic drawl (talk about an oxymoron), a single vowel can substitute for a whole syllable. Try saying the word, "poem." Now say it as a drawl; you can get as many as four whole syllables out of that single word. Amazing. That is why you can pronounce neighboring Taliaferro County as "Toliver," police becomes "poh-leece," and guitar is now "geetar."

And so here we sit at the precipice of change in Southern diction. We shouldn't be surprised, for language is one of the most malleable characteristics of human nature. Get around a bunch of people and observe how your expression changes. At a game and you are yelling at the top of your lungs; in the hospital waiting room and you can hear a pin drop.


I think that is partly our problem today. Social media is, well, social. Dependent on the least dependable part of our character - what we say. The truth is, what we believe is seldom simply articulated in our words and far more in what we do. Or as Edgar Guest once wrote, "I'd rather see a sermon than hear one any day; I'd rather one should walk with me than merely tell the way." And that's why Jesus said the son who did is more righteous than the son that said (Matthew 21:28-31). Or to quote another scripture, "What does the Lord require of you? To act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with your God" (Micah 6:8). The rest of it? It's just talk.


