

I particularly want you to come if you have heard something that has disturbed you - either about what this church practices, professes or believes. No question is off the table, and you will receive inconvertible truth in response to the questions you have or even have heard. Not opinion but truth. For faith is first unafraid and stands on solid ground - not as gossip or rumor. These town hall experiences are designed to last an hour though I will remain for as long as anyone would like so that every concern is addressed. For those who would rather not speak up in a public setting, I want to invite you to email me with your question or questions so that they will be answered. You can ask your questions anonymously. Again, our purpose is to provide clear answers to questions that you or people you know have, or have heard about, or fear. No agenda, just facts.

I encourage your participation. The work of the church demands the truth. At the end of the day, this is about the work of Jesus Christ to the world; it deserves and needs our best and nothing less is faithful.

I encourage you to come to hear the truth, to have your questions answered and most importantly, that the work of Christ be done.


