#### **A Special Gift**

Many of you know that for some time now we at Wesley have realized there was an important area of ministry at our church that was not yet as we imagined it could be special needs. We know that the work of Christ and the redemption it alone provides should be offered wherever there is need. However, the truth is for families who deal with the reality of special needs, it sometimes feels that an experience of church can be as much a burden as blessing. We want to change that. For the last year and more, we have organized a Special Needs Committee at Wesley. This committee has offered support and has researched how we can best reach and welcome families who deal with this reality every day. If the church cannot provide help and hope, who will?

One outcome of the Special Needs Committee was that a grant was written to the North Georgia Conference of the UMC that supports new and innovative ministry ideas. We heard from the Conference with the acknowledgement that this was indeed a good ministry to pursue and as their endorsement they awarded Wesley with a grant that will support the salary of a part-time person who will lead efforts to develop this ministry more fully. It is our hope that what we do here and now at Wesley with this grant will be a source of inspiration and support for other congregations as well. We expect that this grant along with the money this church has collected just before the pandemic might enable our church to extend the reach of God's love a little bit further. It is exciting to imagine.

Throughout October, we will be receiving resumes for this part-time position. Responsibilities will include leadership of the Special Needs Committee and organizing a buddy system which will partner volunteers with people who have special needs so that they may participate fully in ministries here at Wesley. Additionally, we are looking to institute new programs and events that will serve special needs families and adapt other ministries we currently offer so that they may better serve these persons and their families. It is our anticipation that the position would begin January 1 - is there a better way to welcome the new year?

What I have long held at Wesley is that our faith would matter, and it might change lives. We do that in countless ways here at Wesley, and thanks to this grant from the Annual Conference, we are doing it one more time. I just thought you would want to know.


