It Happens to Everyone

Have you ever found yourself needing something? It is the most common experience of all. You're making dinner and discover that you need an item at the grocery store. You are running late and need to pick up the kids from practice. It's cold outside and you need your jacket. Your car won't start, or the tire is flat, and you need assistance. It happens to everyone. That we find ourselves in need is not a revelation. It is our response to need that determines our character.

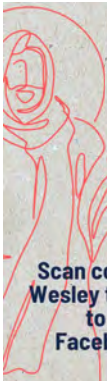
