## Title: God's Grace in the Old Testament *Teacher: Graham Fox (138R)*

Critics of the Bible like to point out the supposed differences between God as he reveals himself in the Old Testament, and how he reveals himself in the new. The Old Testament is full of fire and brimstone, harsh punishment and retribution whereas the New Testament is all about love and grace and forgiveness. This is, obviously, a shallow conclusion. Grace abounds in the entire Bible, and we will focus on some of God's acts of grace revealed in his First Covenants and how these are continued and brought to completion in the Christ Covenant. We will look to find God's grace in our own lives and how we can take advantage of the times God offers us grace—for it really is "new every morning."

Title: Foundations In Christianity: Introduction to the Old Testament

Beginning this summer, we are initiating a new series of classes on Sunday morning: Foundations in Christianity. This series is designed for folks with little to no Bible experience, but open to anyone who would like a "refresher" in the basics of the Bible and our core beliefs. The first class in this series will be an *Introduction to the Old Testament* focusing on the overarching narrative of the Old Testament and how these stories combine to help us understand and anticipate Jesus Christ. Subsequent classes will include an Introduction to the New Testament, highlighting our Lord Jesus, to be followed by a class called Hardin Valley: Who we Are, detailing our core beliefs (formerly called Hardin Valley 101). The first two classes will last longer than our regular 13 weeks and will be taught throughout the remainder of 2025. The final class in this series will be taught beginning in Ian 2026.
