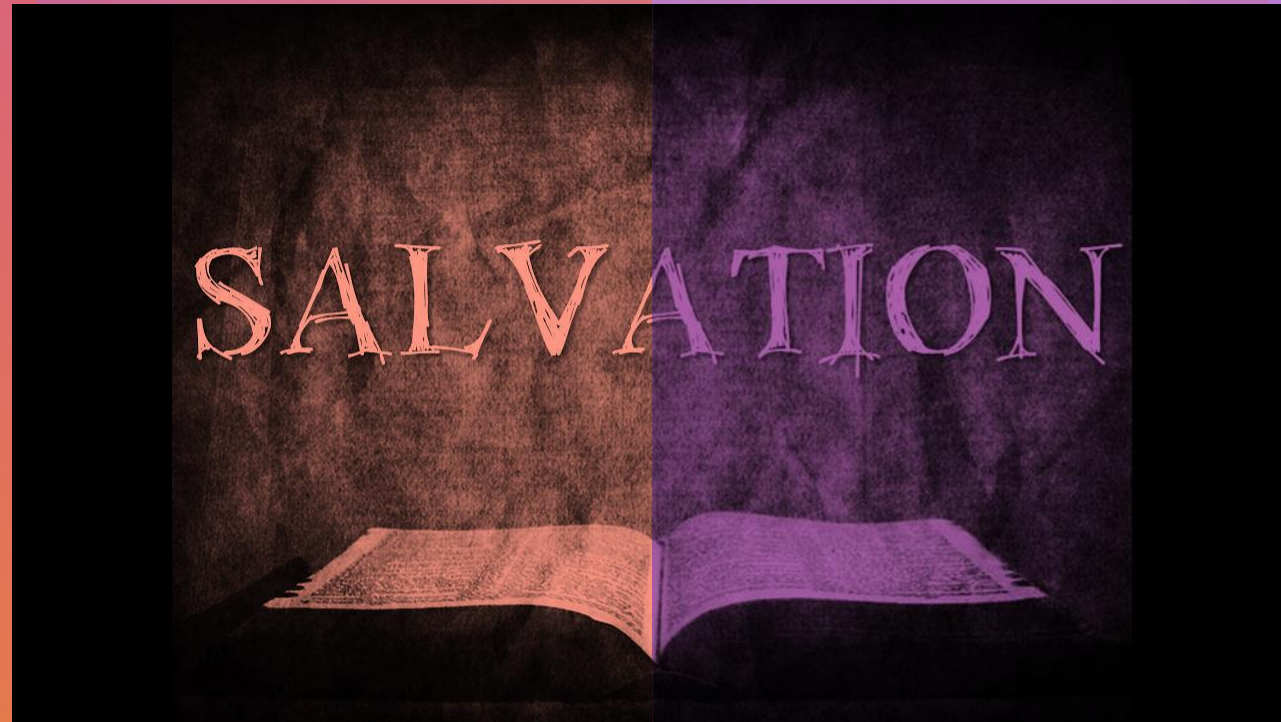

# Salvation

- Salvation in the Old Testament
  - Mostly material and temporal salvation
  - Some notable exceptions in the prophet Isaiah
- Salvation in the New Testament
  - A new kind of salvation in the forgiveness of sins
  - A new kind of salvation in Jesus the Christ
  - A new kind of salvation through the power of the Gospel

- A salvation **from** sin and the wrath of God
- A salvation **for** eternal life

# Jesus was the Temple

- John 2:18-24

<sup>18</sup> So the Jews said to him, “What sign do you show us for doing these things?” <sup>19</sup> Jesus answered them, “Destroy this **temple**, and in three days I will raise it up.” <sup>20</sup> The Jews then said, “It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?” <sup>21</sup> But he was speaking about the **temple of his body**.

# We are the Temple

- 1 Corinthians. 3:9-10; 16

You are God's field, **God's building**.

<sup>10</sup> According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it.

<sup>16</sup> Do you not know that you are **God's temple** and that **God's Spirit dwells in you**? <sup>17</sup> If anyone destroys **God's temple**, God will destroy him. For **God's temple** is holy, and **you are that temple**.



# We are the Temple

- 2 Corinthians 6:10; 16

<sup>16</sup> What agreement has the **temple of God** with idols? For **we are the temple of the living God**; as God said,  
“I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them,  
and I will be their God,  
and they shall be my people.”



# We are the Temple

- Ephesians 2:19-22

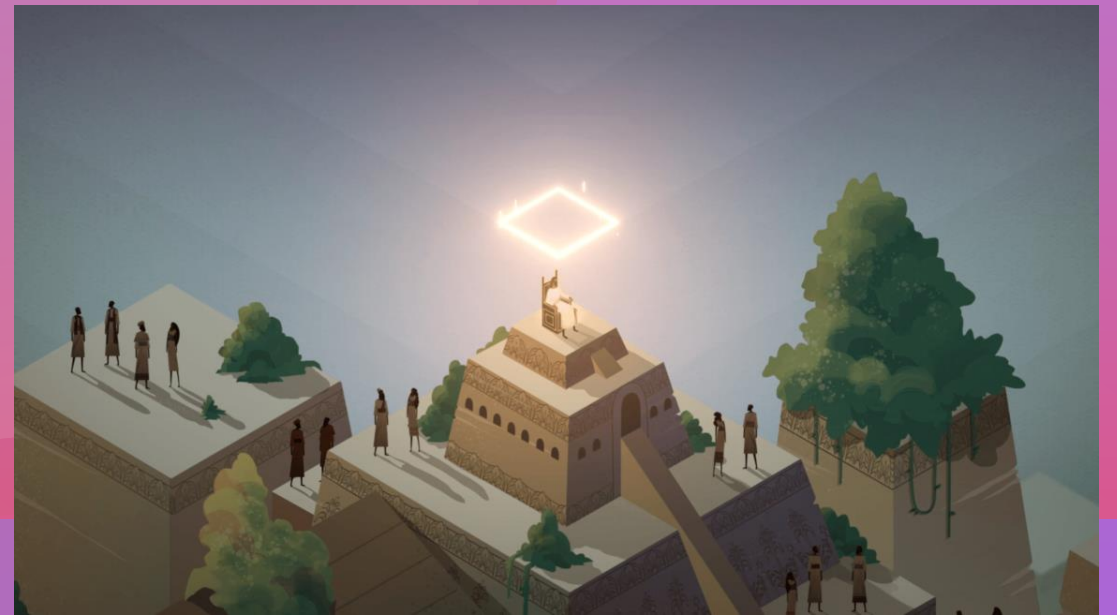
<sup>19</sup> So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the **household of God**, <sup>20</sup> built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, <sup>21</sup> in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a **holy temple in the Lord**. <sup>22</sup> In him you also are being built together into a **dwelling place for God by the Spirit**.



# We are the Temple

- 1 Peter 2:4-5

<sup>4</sup> As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, <sup>5</sup> **you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house**, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
