



Formula Comparison

Old vs New - Effective 2026

Pastor Count	Old Formula [k]	New Formula [k]
1	190	220
2	420	490
3	740	860
4	1.150	1.350
5	1.650	1.900
6	2.150	2.480
7	2.650	3.060





Why Change Now?

"Change before you have to." Jack Welch



SECC's current tithe threshold is unsustainable

- Rising costs: insurance, healthcare, inflation
- Tithe deficit: 2024 = \$2.4M deficit

Last update was over 10 years ago

Implementation Plan

2026 - 2028

- Three-year phased implementation plan
- Stewardship growth resources for pastors and congregations
- Continued communication, transparency and collaboration
- Yearly evaluation and adjustment





Staffing Guidance

We are not entering into a hiring freeze, nor are we considering layoffs. We are simply not adding positions. Instead we are walking through this process in a healthy and collaborative way, trusting God to sustain His mission.

No new pastoral positions created.

Vacancies filled only if threshold met.

Attrition used for under - threshold churches.

4 Yearly assessment of progress

Scenarios



Two-Pastor Church

Tithe = \$325k and no growth

New formula requires \$490k (gap \$165k)

Sr Pastor is retiring in 6 months.

Attrition: Downsize to 1 pastor upon Sr. Pastor's retirement.



Tithe = \$420k

New formula requires \$490k (gap \$70k)

Three years to adapt, evaluate yearly progress and determine next steps.





One-Pastor Church

Tithe = \$190k and consistently declining tithe & attendance.

New Formula requires \$220k

Evaluate progress yearly, and determine next steps. Possible districting and pastoral transition.



Mission Alignment



Mission Focus

This is not only about the numbers – it's about mission.



Sustainability

Adjusting ensures we can sustain pastoral ministry, evangelism, education, and community impact.



Resources

Resource alignment keeps mission central.

Biblical Principle for Adaptation



- Joseph planned ahead for lean times [Genesis 41]
- Paul adapted methods for mission [1 Corinthians 9:22]
- Stewardship = faithfulness and wise adaptation
