

Help Abram and his family find their way to the new land.




"Leave your country," God told Abram, "I will bless you in a new land." Abram obeyed God and left his country.

Bible Story

The Call of Abram (Genesis 12:1-4)

God went with Abram and God goes also with you. Make a string rubbing poster to remind you that God is with you wherever you go.

Get Ready

Peeled crayons
Drawing paper
String
Tape

Get Set

1. Cut string into 12" to 18" lengths.
2. Set out crayons and paper.
3. Demonstrate the project.


Go


1. Lay your string down in front of you in a circular design.
2. Place a piece of paper over the string. Tape the corners of the paper to the table so that it stays in place. Rub over it with the side of a crayon.
3. Change the placement of the string and rub over it with another crayon. Continue with more colors.
4. Write "God Goes with Me" on the poster.

Other Ideas

1. Use string to outline a specific state you have been to or to draw the outline of a place you would like to visit.
2. Lay several pieces of string across the paper to represent water.
3. Glue string to a piece of cardboard to make several prints of your string picture. Consider using this technique to make simple Christmas or Easter pictures or cards.
4. Cover the completed picture with a watercolor wash.
5. Make an abstract string rubbing for a picture of praise.
6. Frame your paper by gluing it to a larger piece of construction paper.

BIBLE STORY

God's Promise to Abraham
(Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6)

MATERIALS

Large sheet of blue or black
construction paper

Newspaper

Tempera paint (light colors)

Water

Detergent

Wide-bristle brush




DIRECTIONS

1. Cover work area with newspaper.
2. Place construction paper in center of newspaper.
3. Mix water with tempera until paint drips easily from brush. Add a little detergent to aid in cleanup.
4. Dip brush into paint and drip over paper to make stars. Make a special star to show that Jesus would be born one day from Abraham's family to be our Savior.
5. If you wish, title the picture "As Many as the Stars."

OTHER IDEAS

1. Have several children work together to make a class mural.
2. Write the words *As Many as the Stars* with a white crayon.
3. Drip paint over a picture to illustrate the sky over Bethlehem the night Jesus was born, or to show God's nighttime creation.
4. Sprinkle glitter over wet tempera paint.




Attach other end of string to a paper plate.



Attach another string through both holes
