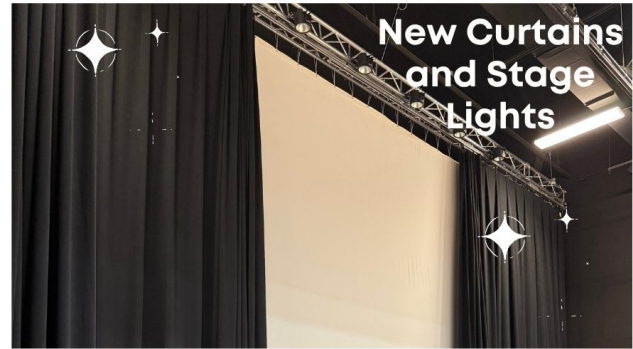

CONCORDIA LUTHERAN SCHOOL JOB OPENINGS

Concordia Lutheran School is seeking to fill the following positions for the 2025-2026 school year.

- **Teacher's Aide:** A Concordia Lutheran School Teacher's Aide assists instructional staff with student supervision, assessment, and individualized student needs. Candidates for this position must have a good rapport with students in kindergarten through eighth grades. Candidates for this position must be willing to follow the guidance of the lead teacher, continually seeking to enhance the learning process. All employees are expected to act in a manner that supports the Statement of Belief for the Lutheran Central School Association of Peoria and live in a manner that exemplifies the Concordia Lutheran School Christian Code of Conduct. Compensation is based on an hourly rate. There is potential for part-time positions that include 15-28 hours per week.
- **Substitute Teachers:** Concordia Lutheran School is seeking substitute teachers to serve on an "as-needed" basis. It is preferred that substitute teachers have, at a minimum, an associate's degree and a teaching license or substitute teacher certification.
