CLS TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTOR OPPORTUNITY



MIDWEST FOOD BANK VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

Trinity Lutheran's volunteer dates are:

- 9:00-11:00 a.m., Wednesday, September 24 (10 volunteer openings)
- 9:00-11:00 a.m., Wednesday, October 22 (15 volunteer openings) will be assisting in packing the Salvation Army/PNC/Midwest Food Bank Christmas Food Boxes for the Peoria area.
- 9:00-11:00 a.m., Tuesday, November 18 (10 volunteer openings)

Food Bank Volunteering FAQ

- Are there any dress requirements? All volunteers must wear closed-toed, closed-heeled shoes such as tennis shoes/sneakers. For your safety, crocs, slides or sandals are not allowed to be worn in the warehouse.
- **Do we need to bring any personal safety equipment?** No. For those volunteering during the day, we provide hi-vis vests to our volunteers to wear while in the warehouse. Any gloves, hairnets, or other food safety equipment will also be provided for all bulk repackaging projects.
- What will we be doing? Most groups will repackage bulk food/products into family-sized bags. These family-sized bags will be distributed within the next two months to our partner agencies. We partner with 350 agencies. Depending on the need, you could be packaging our product called Tender Mercies.
- **How many can volunteer within one group at a time?** For service projects, we can accommodate up to 25 volunteers at a time within our project area.
- What is the address of where we will be volunteering? Midwest Food Bank, Peoria is located at 9005 N Industrial Rd, Peoria IL 61615
- Where do we park and enter? You can park anywhere in our lot. If the parking lot is full, there is an overflow lot on the southwest corner of the main parking lot that is to the left of the white shack/hut. Our volunteer entrance is in the corner where the two buildings intersect to form a "L" shape. Once inside, you'll check in at the kiosk by finding your name or you can scan your group's QR code that will be on the TV by the Midwest Food Bank fabric backdrop.
- **How old do you need to be to volunteer?** Volunteers must be 5 years old or older. Children aged 5 to 10 must be accompanied by their parent(s).
