



INTENDED AUDIENCE: SPECIFICALLY WRITTEN TO THEOPHILUS, A ROMAN DIGNITARY. PERHAPS NEW TO CHRIST

INTERESTING FACT: SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON WOMEN AS MAJOR ROLES IN THE FAITH

UNIQUE TO BOOK: RICH MAN AND LAZARUS, SALVATION OF THE THIEF ON CROSS, AND THE PRODIGAL SON

KEY VERSE: FOR TODAY IN THE CITY OF DAVID THERE HAS BEEN

JOHN 3:16

SPECIAL INSIGHT: LUKE WAS A HISTORIAN AND HE INCLUDED ALL OF THE TINY DETAILS, FACTS, AND DESCRIPTIONS IN HIS BOOK. LONGEST OF ALL FOUR GOSPELS SPECIAL INSIGHT: JOHN WAS ONE OF CLOSEST DISCIPLES TO CHRIST, WITNESSED THE TRANSFIGURATION, FIRST TO EMPTY TOMB, LIVED LONGEST OF DISCIPLES

DATE: A.D. 50-60

UNIQUE TO BOOK: MORE FOCUS ON WORKS OVER WORDS

INTENDED AUDIENCE: GENTILES AND ROMAN BELIEVERS

DEFINES ARAMAIC WORDS TO HELP THE NON-JEWISH READERS

AUTHOR: DISCIPLE OF PETER, COUSIN OF BARNABAS

THEME: THE DEEDS AND MIRACLES OF JESUS; CHRIST AS A SUFFERING SERVANT OF GOD

INTERESTING FACT: WRITTEN IN BASIC GREEK, EXPLAINS JEWISH CUSTOMS, AND

KEY VERSE: FOR EVEN THE SON OF MAN DID NOT COME TO BE SERVED, BUT TO SERVE, AND GIVE HIS LIFE A RANSOM FOR MANY MARK 10:45

DATE: A.D. 50-70

SPECIAL INSIGHT: MARK WROTE THIS **BOOK USING THE TEACHINGS AND THE** TESTIMONY OF PETER THE APOSTLE.

AUTHOR: INNER CIRCLE OF JESUS' DISCIPLES, FISHERMAN, AND ALSO WRITER OF BOOK OF REVELATION

DATE: A.D. 80-90, WRITTEN IN EXILE

INTENDED AUDIENCE: WRITTEN FOR UNBELIEVERS SO THAT THEY MAY FIND ETERNAL LIFE, AND FOR BELIEVERS SO THAT THEY MAY FIND ASSURANCE

THEME: THE DEITY OF CHRIST, ETERNAL LIFE

NTERESTING FACT: JOHN REPLACES HIS NAME IN THIS GOSPEL WITH "WHOM JESUS LOVED"

UNIQUE TO BOOK: WATER TO WINE, RAISING OF LAZARUS, THE "I AM" STATEMENTS, THOMAS DOUBTS, PETER'S RESTORATION



In the Gospels of Mark and John, we basically start the story when Jesus is 30!

- Mark: Begins with Jesus' baptism (Jesus from 30-33 years old)
- John: Begins with, "Let me tell you about the eternal WORD, the true LIGHT..." and Jesus' baptism is also in chapter one (but this gospel is not a chronological narrative)

In the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, Jesus' Baptism (30–33) is in chapter three!

- Matthew: Begins first two chapters with genealogies, the birth of Jesus, the wisemen, and the flight to Egypt, then Jesus' begins ministry
- Luke: Begins first two chapters with Zacheus, Birth, Songs, Shepherds, and our passage today: Jesus' presentation at the temple as a baby and 12-year-old Jesus



LEVITICUS 12:8







- 8. What things do you need to put into practice in your life from this chapter?
