



Recent things Jesus has said in the book of Luke!


I am the one who can forgive sins


I am the one who came for the sick

AS A GIFT TO MANKIND, A DAY OF REST, IS A GIFT THAT SHOULD BE PRACTICED





Sabbath

SINCE JESUS IS THE FULFILLMENT OF THE SABBATH WE CAN EXPERIENCE THE REST OF RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM EVERYDAY
