Daniel 4:30-31, 33 NIV



"The reward for humility and fear of the LORD is riches and honor and life."













Turn to Proverbs 3:34-35

Have the Almighty and powerful God against - OR - powerful and loving God showing you favor...



- Believes God exists and rewards
- Is not anxious, for God is trustworthy!
