MINISTRY

The team of 17 served at the Aeta Children's Home (ACH) and to the community north of the Subic Bay region of the island of Luzon. This region includes a dispersed refugee community of the Aeta tribal peoples displaced after the eruption of Mount Pinatubo in the early 1990's.

The team's ministry included the following:

- Attending and preaching at several churches
- Playing games with the children
- Teaching 125 children in their academic classrooms (grades K-10)
- Conducting a Vacation Bible School (VBS) for all 125 children
- Leading evening devotionals
- Conducting a medical mission in a remote village (240 patients)
- Funding and participating in a field trip to Dinosaur Island and the Clark Museum
- Conducting a pastors and wives conference
- Providing 100 water filter systems and training the pastors and teachers on their use
- Funding and distributing food and gifts at the medical mission, to villagers, and to pastors and their wives
