

Life Group Sermon Guide Questions 12 OCTOBER 2025



Opening: Read Psalm 100

- 1) When you hear the phrase "Faithful God; Faithful Sheep," what stands out to you most?
- 2) Psalm 100 invites us to "make a joyful noise" and "serve with gladness." What do those words mean to you personally?

Looking Back: God's Faithfulness Across Generations

- 3) Read Joshua 4:6-7. Why does God ask Israel to collect stones from the bottom of the Jordan? Why is it good to remember the work of God in previous generations?
- 4) UCM was founded in 1914 through a merger of different denominations. How does that story inspire or challenge you today?
- 5) What are some ways you've seen God's faithfulness at UCM, or in your own spiritual journey?

6) The sermon compared UCM to a mighty oak tree with deep, unseen roots. What "roots" (values, practices, examples) have been passed down to us by earlier generations of the church?

Living Now: Our Present Call

- 7) Psalm 100 calls us to "serve the Lord with gladness." Where do you currently feel called to serve in your life, and what helps you serve with joy?
- 8) The message reminded us that the church is not just a building but a living community. How has UCM (or your local church experience) been meaningful to you in worship, fellowship, or growth?
- 9) Read Hebrews 10:24-25. What is the central purpose of the church? How are we called to fulfill this role through UCM?
- 10) We heard that UCM is known for being a welcoming community, offering uplifting worship, relevant teaching, and space for spiritual growth. Which of these resonates most with your experience, and why?

Looking Ahead: Faithfulness to Future Generations

- 11) Psalm 100:5 reminds us that God's faithfulness extends to "all generations." What kind of spiritual heritage do you hope to leave for the next generation? Read Psalm 78:4 and Joel 1:3. What is our responsibility to future generations?
- 12) The sermon introduced the *Next Steps Hub* as a way of moving forward in faith. What "next step" might God be calling you to take right now—personally or within the church community?
- 13) In what ways can we ensure that Union Church of Manila continues to be a light in the city and a refuge for future generations?
