Exodus 33:1-6, 12-16

To begin:

What is something that you would consider indispensable to your life?

OR

Describe a defining quality about yourself.

Before you proceed:

First, as you can, read Exodus 33:1-6, 12-16 aloud in your group. If you have time, read it aloud a second time - from a different Bible translation. If you have time, read it aloud a third time - from an even different Bible translation.

As you begin your discussion, pray and ask God to speak to your group. Notice, what may God be highlighting for your discussion and learning?

Now that you have read the text together and prayed, what points and questions arise from your group? Spend plenty of time in your group to address these points and questions. Explore and see how God may give guidance in the discussion. The following are further questions you may use to guide your interaction with the text.

- How would you describe the central conflict in this account?
- How did Moses respond?
- Why did this matter?
- How is this passage relevant for today?
- What resonated with you from this passage?
- What will you carry with you into the coming week?
