

Life Group Sermon Guide Questions 21 DECEMBER 2025



Read Luke 2

Conversation starter: Tell about a time you received a gift that didn't match what you expected (or you gave one that totally missed). What did it reveal about what you were hoping for?

- 1. As you heard Luke 2 today, what detail grabbed you—something you'd never noticed before, or something that you saw differently?
- 2. In the story, different people respond to Jesus' arrival in different ways (Mary, Joseph, shepherds, angels). Who do you most relate to right now, and why?
- 3. Luke shows a King born in humility—no spotlight, no palace. What does that say about what God is like and what He values?

- 4. The angels announce, "I bring you good news of great joy... for all the people." Where do you feel or realize the "for me" of that personally right now? Where do you imagine the "for all" (the wideness of God's mercy)?
- 5. What tends to keep you from actually receiving Jesus as King in daily life—busyness, control, disappointment, fear, comfort, cynicism, or something else?
- 6. Given Jesus is King, what's one concrete area where you can yield ground this week (time, money, words, habits, relationships, screens, forgiveness)? What would obedience look like in one small, specific step?
- 7. If you were going to "give a gift to Jesus" this week, not to earn anything, but in love, what would it be (adoration, repentance, generosity, service, reconciliation, witness, a surrendered plan)? Pray and ask the Lord to help you receive Him as King and to offer Him that gift—not with any tinge of duty or obligation, but with pure delight.
