Joshua 10:4-14

Discovery

- 1. What specific actions did the five Amorite kings take against Gibeon (vv. 4-5), and what was Joshua's immediate response to Gibeon's plea (vv. 6-7, 9)?
- 2. Identify the two distinct and extraordinary ways God directly intervened in the battle on Israel's behalf (vv. 12-14).

Understanding

3. What does God's reassurance to Joshua (v. 8) and His subsequent miraculous interventions reveal about His commitment to Israel and His power over creation?

4. Consider Joshua's bold command for the sun and moon to stand still (vv. 12-13). What does this request, and God's granting of it, teach us about faith, prayer, and the unique nature of this event in salvation history (v. 14)?

Application

- 5. When facing an overwhelming alliance of "enemies" (challenges, problems, opposition) in your life, how does Israel's reliance on God's direct intervention (v. 10) encourage you to pray and act?
- 6. Joshua boldly asked God for something unprecedented (vv. 12-13). What "impossible" situations in your life or community might God be calling you to approach with audacious faith and prayer?
- 7. Verse 14 states, "There has been no day like it before or since, when the LORD heeded the voice of a man." While unique, how can the principle of God working powerfully in response to earnest human appeal inspire your intercession for seemingly insurmountable obstacles?
