Faithless	Faithfull	“So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.” — <i>James 2:17</i>
Inaction	Obedience	“Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.” — <i>Romans 6:13</i>
Silent	Vocal	“And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.” — <i>Acts 4:31</i>
Compromise	Conviction	“But Peter and the apostles answered, ‘We must obey God rather than men.’” — <i>Acts 5:29</i>
Apathetic	Zeal	“[Jesus]... gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.” — <i>Titus 2:14</i>
Complacent	Watchful / Vigilant	“Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.” — <i>1 Peter 5:8</i>
Hesitant	Decisive	“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” — <i>Joshua 1:9</i>
Weak	Empowered	“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might.” — <i>Ephesians 6:10</i>
Submissive to evil	Resistant to evil	“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” — <i>James 4:7</i>
Resignation	Endure	“And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.” — <i>Galatians 6:9</i>
