COUNCIL TIME: HEARING GOD'S WORD

Clubbers will participate in a time of worship that includes an exciting time of songs, prayer, a Bible lesson, awards and announcements.

HANDBOOK TIME: SAYING GOD'S WORD

All clubbers recite verses that they have learned. The verses are grouped together and are called sections. Leaders sign off these sections after the clubbers successfully complete them. Our goal is to have the clubbers understand the meaning of the verses they are learning.

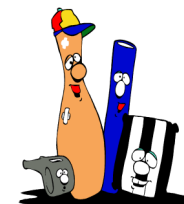
GAME TIME: APPLYING GOD'S WORD

Clubbers learn good sportsmanship and have lots of fun by participating in exciting game activities. Please have your clubber wear athletic shoes and please no dresses or skirts for the young ladies. Everyone will have more fun if they are dressed appropriately.

*** IMPORTANT ***

PICKING UP CLUBBERS

We ask that you pick up your clubber **promptly at 7:45**. It is the policy of our Awana Club that Cubbies and Sparks will only be released to their parents. We will allow another adult to pick up your child if you fill out a permission form designating another person to do so.



SOME RULES...

- Please plan to take part in the entire club night. If you are unable to participate in the games because of an injury, please bring a note from home. We require everyone to participate.
- Please come early for check in so that we may start club on time.

All clubbers are to bring their club handbook and Bible. If you do not have a Bible, please ask your leader and we will get you one.

- **Please wear proper attire to our Awana Club meetings:**
 1. Wear athletic shoes to participate in games.
 2. All clubbers should be in their Awana uniform, if it has been earned.
 3. Girls should wear pants or shorts - No dresses or skirts. All clubbers are to be respectful to the leadership. The leaders are here for you.
- Come to attention and stop talking when the Commander, Director, or a leader is giving a 5 count. They have something important to tell you about!
- A clubber who disrupts the club meeting with inappropriate behavior will be given a one count by the Leader and is told that the behavior needs to stop. If the clubber continues to be disruptive, he is given a two count and taken to the Director. If the behavior continues, the clubber is given a three count and is sent home by the Commander.

UNIFORMS

A uniform reinforces the club program, helps to promote pride in the club, and gives clubbers a place to display their awards. Their uniform will be purchased when they register online.

MAJOR AWARDS



- **First Handbook**

Ribbons are awarded for the completion of the first handbook.

- **Second Handbook**

Sparks receive a large ribbon for the completion of two consecutive handbooks.

- **Excellence Award**

Excellence trophy is awarded upon completion of two 3rd through 12th grade handbooks.

- **Third Book Award**

Third Book trophy is awarded to 3rd through 12th grade boys and girls completing three consecutive books.

- **Sparky Award**

All Sparks who complete all three club handbooks receive a plaque and a pin to wear on their uniform. This pin may also be worn on their uniform when they graduate to the next Awana Club.

- **Timothy Award**

The Timothy trophy is awarded upon completion of four 3rd through 12th grade handbooks.
