SERMON APPLICATION REVIEW

What is God saying to you today?

STUDY QUESTIONS

- 1. Why is it important that our praying is Scripture-fed?
- 2. Why is it so important that we begin our times of prayer with worship? How much of your praying is worship?
- 3. How often do your times of prayer include a response of submission of your will or surrender to trust God?
- 4. Take inventory of the things you have been asking God to do for you. How would God be glorified in answering those requests? How might your requests need to be adjusted to be for the glory of God?
- 5. Will you set aside time each day for Scripture-fed, worship-based prayer? When?
