SCRIPTURE READING

Galatians 6:1-10; Galatians 5:13-26; James 5:19-20; Romans 15:1; 1 Corinthians 9:21; 2 Corinthians 3:5-15; 2 Corinthians 9:1-15

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. How is the response to restore someone caught in sin distinct from the pattern we see in the world? (6:1)
2. How does bearing each other's burdens reflect the love of Christ? In what way does it "fulfill the law of Christ"? (6:2)
3. How should the promise of eternal reward fuel us to bear each other's burdens, share our goods, and do good to all, especially to the family of faith? (6:3-10)
4. Why is the idea of karma unbiblical and how is it different from the biblical principle of sowing and reaping? (6:7-8) How can this passage keep us motivated even when we don't see fruit in our discipleship relationships? (6:9)?
5. How should the priority that this passage places upon the local church affect our own priorities? (6:10) What is one specific way God is calling you to bear burdens, share goods, or do good, and how will your community group know if you obey him?
