A NOTE FROM PASTOR TANNER HUSS

Most Christians have never been discipled nor had a spiritual mentor. Many also feel that, with a little more training, they could make disciples, become a spiritual mentor for those a step or two behind them in following Jesus. Whether you are new to the faith or have followed Jesus for years, Discipleship Classes are designed to equip you to be a disciple who builds disciples.

In Ephesians 4:11-16, we learn that the body of Christ, the church, is built up by Christ as each member of the body plays its part. Every member of the body of Christ has a role to fulfill. We are all being built up as disciples who, in turn, build disciples. So, how can we be built up as disciples within the body of Christ? What practical steps are you taking to follow Jesus and help others do the same?

At Crossroads, we take seriously our responsibility to help you be a disciple of Jesus and build disciples of Jesus. Our mission is building disciples who bring Jesus to our world. We want to equip everyone who calls Crossroads home to be a disciple of Jesus who builds disciples who bring the good news of Jesus to our neighborhoods, workplaces, schools, communities, and even across the globe.

This desire shapes our Discipleship Pathway: Planted in Truth, Rooted in Community, Reaching in Love. We are planted in truth together, first through gathering on Sunday to worship and hear the Word of God preached, but we also gather in other ways throughout the week. Sunday mornings alone aren't enough for us to fully live out what the church was meant to be. That is why we encourage everyone to be Rooted in Community by joining a Community Group. Discipleship

happens in relationships. In a Community Group, we can live out the various ways we are called to love one another in the family of faith. It's often here that we start to feel truly connected to each other and the church—living life together, supporting one another through life's highs and lows, and always pointing each other back to Jesus.

But the journey of discipleship doesn't stop there. Mature disciples are called to be Reaching in Love, which means making more disciples, serving at CBC, engaging locally in our Eastside community, and even reaching globally in some way.

A disciple is simply a learner or follower. Much of our discipleship involves learning from God's Word and Christlike examples, then living out what we have learned. This is where Discipleship Classes come in. The life of discipleship is multifaceted and complex. There is a lot to learn to become more like Jesus and lead others to do the same.

Our Discipleship Classes cover a wide range of topics to better equip you to be a disciple who builds disciples. Whether you have just come to faith in Jesus or have been following him for years, there is a class for you.


