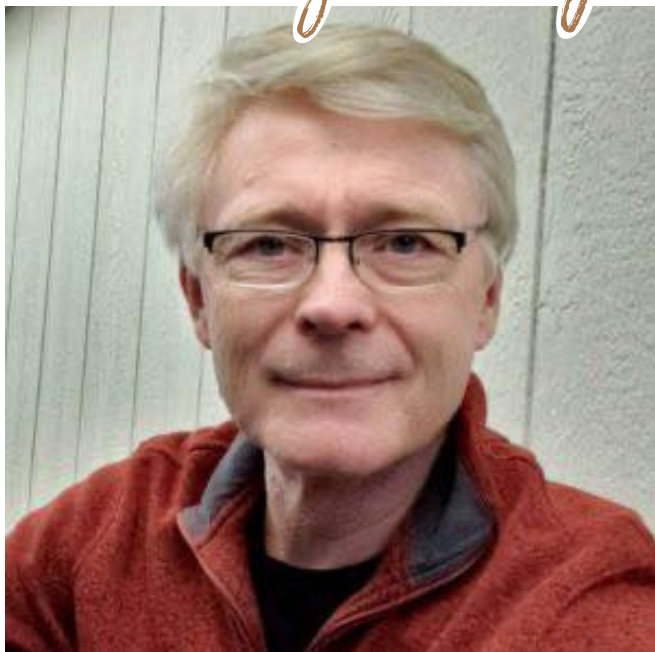

Larry graduated from Renton High School and attended Green River College where he managed the campus radio station which launched a broadcasting career that spanned over 40 years. His career had him on-air across the USA, even recording while vacationing in other countries. The last 20 years were working with CRISTA Ministries on Spirit 105.3 and Praise 106.5. Larry loved everything about the radio world including the artists, co-workers, hosting concerts and events, and sharing his faith in Jesus Christ with the listening audience.
