**Sow to Reap** is about creating an environment where kids encounter Jesus, where guests feel seen and welcomed, and where community groups can flourish. Sow to Reap is *expanding kids and community for eternal growth.*

### What is Sow to Reap?

**Sow to Reap is a capital campaign that will launch in September 2025** to renovate our Kids ministry area and expand our community spaces.

**Why Community?** - At CBC, we value caring community. We recognize our growing need for functional spaces where communities can gather and grow in discipleship.
